

Security Statement

Application Penetration Test "Celatum"

Scope

By order of Salvioni Digital Solutions, Oneconsult AG (Oneconsult) conducted an authenticated grey box penetration test of the desktop application Celatum version 1.0.1, including automated and manual testing. The tests were performed on 15 and 16 June 2026.

The main objectives were:

- ▶ Verifying that user data never leaves the user's device
- ▶ Confirming that the application only communicates with the internet for license handling
- ▶ Assessing if the application follows current security good practices

This project was carried out according to the guidelines of the Open Source Security Testing Methodology Manual (OSSTMM) which are developed and published by the Institute for Security and Open Methodologies (ISECOM). All consultants involved in the project are certified OSSTMM Professional Security Testers (OPST) and have completed many OSSTMM-based projects in recent years. Particular attention was given to the OWASP Top 10 Desktop Application Security Risks and the technology-specific security best practices.

Result

The penetration test showed that the application has an overall high security level, and no high- or critical-rated vulnerabilities were identified during the assessment. The tests confirmed that the application does not communicate with the internet except for activating, verifying, and deactivating licenses. No documents or data entered into the application during the tests were ever sent via the network by Celatum, and they were saved only when and where intended by the user.

It should be noted that these results only represent a snapshot of the situation at the time of testing and cannot guarantee that there will be no vulnerabilities in future revisions of the software.
